<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ <b>Every Visit</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Height, weight</li> <li>✓ Blood pressure</li> <li>✓ Physical exam</li> <li>✓ Developmental and behavioral assessment</li> <li>✓ Hearing/subjective</li> </ul> </li>   <li>◆ <b>Additional</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Vision screen <i>Every other year.</i></li> <li>✓ PPD <i>If at risk<sup>2</sup></i></li> <li>✓ Dental referral <i>If not seen yet.</i></li> <li>✓ Screen for sexual activity; Pap and pelvic as needed. <i>At and beyond 11 years of age.</i></li> <li>✓ Hepatitis C <i>(if at risk)<sup>3</sup></i></li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ <b>Nutrition</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Food groups</li> <li>✓ Calcium</li> <li>✓ Healthy snacks</li> <li>✓ Body image</li> <li>✓ Limiting saturated fat intake</li> </ul> </li>   <li>◆ <b>Injury Prevention<sup>4</sup></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Seat belt use</li> <li>✓ Bicycle helmets</li> <li>✓ Poison awareness</li> <li>✓ Fire safety</li> <li>✓ Firearms</li> </ul> </li>   <li>◆ <b>Dental Health</b></li>   <li>◆ <b>Substance Use/Abuse</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Tobacco, alcohol, drugs</li> </ul> </li>   <li>◆ <b>Depression</b></li>   <li>◆ <b>Family Adjustment</b></li>   <li>◆ <b>Promotion of Nonviolent Problem Solving</b></li>   <li>◆ <b>Scholastic Performance</b></li>   <li>◆ <b>Family Violence or Sexual Abuse</b></li>   <li>◆ <b>Sexuality</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ <b>All Children</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Hepatitis B <i>3-dose series at any age if not previously immunized<sup>5</sup></i></li> <li>✓ Td booster <i>At age 11 if at least 5 years since last dose.</i></li> <li>✓ MMR <i>At any time if 2 doses not previously given after age 12 mos.<sup>9</sup></i></li> <li>✓ Varicella vaccine <i>If no evidence of immunity<sup>10</sup></i></li> <li>✓ Influenza vaccine <i>Annually<sup>12</sup></i></li> <li>✓ Meningococcal vaccine <i>Age 11-12<sup>14</sup></i></li> <li>✓ Tdap <i>One dose at 11-12 years of age and catch up<sup>24</sup></i></li> <li>✓ HPV- <i>One dose for girls at 11-12 years of age<sup>18</sup></i></li> <li>✓ Hepatitis A- <i>If at risk for children ages 2-18 years of age.<sup>21</sup></i></li> </ul> </li>   <li>◆ <b>High Risk Children</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Pneumococcal vaccine <i>If at risk and not previously immunized<sup>11</sup></i></li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><i>See attached immunization schedule</i></p>
