

## Important Information Regarding Coverage for Some Low Cost Generic Drugs

Starting May 18, 2010, Neighborhood will require that certain low cost generic maintenance drugs be dispensed in quantities equal to a 90 day supply. This initiative will help reduce costs, increase patient compliance, and help reduce your work volume.

A list of the drugs that must be dispensed in 90 day supplies is available on the Neighborhood website [www.NHPRI.org](http://www.NHPRI.org). The list will be updated from time to time. In addition, as part of the adjudication process, Neighborhood's PBM (Argus) will prompt you on when to dispense the 90 days supply.

We understand there will be situations when the 90 days supply is not possible or appropriate (i.e. insufficient quantity on the prescription, or the prescription is a trial or for titration purposes). In these situations, please call Neighborhood Customer Service for assistance at 401-459-6020.
