Required Medical Information:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Patient is being treated for fibromyalgia, neuropathic pain or post herpetic neuralgia and has failed a recent trial of adequate dose and duration of duloxetine and at least 1 of the following drugs or drug classes: TCAs, SSRIs, cyclobenzaprine or pramipexole due to inadequate response and/or intolerance • Patient is being treated for postherpetic neuralgia or neuropathic pain associated with spinal cord injury and has failed a recent trial with gabapentin dosed at 1800mg per day and at least 1 of the following drugs or drug classes: TCAs, SSRIs, cyclobenzaprine or pramipexole due to inadequate response and/or intolerance or • Patient is being treated for seizures and has failed a recent trial with at least two of the following drugs or drug classes: carbamazepine, topiramate, valproic acid, gabapentin, oxcarbazepine, lamotrigine, tiagabine, zonisamide, levetiracetam or phenytoin due to inadequate response and/or intolerance
