

Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit Changes

Neighborhood News – April 2026

Effective **February 1, 2026**, Neighborhood has updated its Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit to remove **Prolia/Xgeva** and **Jobbonti/Wyost** from the Medicaid Formulary. Neighborhood now **exclusively prefers Bildyos/Bilprevda**.

Authorizations for Prolia/Xgeva and Jobbonti/Wyost terminated as of February 1, 2026.

Effective **February 1, 2026**, Neighborhood updated its Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit to remove **Dulera** from the Medicaid Formulary. Neighborhood **exclusively prefers the products listed below**.

- **Fluticasone-Salmeterol** (AirDuo Respiclick generic, Advair Diskus generic, Advair HFA generic)
- **Wixela Inhub** (fluticasone-salmeterol pow)
- **Fluticasone-Vilanterol 100 & 200 mg** (Breo Ellipta generic)
- **Budesonide-Formoterol** (Symbicort Generic)
- **Breyna** (Symbicort Generic)

Special Note

- **Dulera 50 mcg/5 mcg** remains on formulary **without restriction for members under 6 years old**.
- Members who have used Dulera 100 mcg/5 mcg or 200 mcg/5 mcg, and members older than 6 years old who have used Dulera 50 mcg/5 mcg in the last 6 months, will have access to remain on Dulera through **December 31, 2026**.

These changes do not affect Neighborhood Commercial or Medicare members
