

Required Medical Evaluation Form for SNF LTSS Waiver Submissions

Neighborhood News – April 2026

Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island (Neighborhood) is reminding skilled nursing facility (SNF) providers of a new state requirement related to Long-Term Services and Supports (LTSS) waiver submissions.

[As communicated by the State of Rhode Island](#) last month, a completed [Medical Evaluation of Applicant for Level of Care \(GW OMR-PM-1\)](#) is now required as part of the [LTSS waiver application](#) for skilled nursing facility (SNF) services.

Neighborhood does not complete this form on behalf of providers. The form must be fully completed and submitted by the provider to the Department of Human Services as part of the waiver packet.

Failure to include the required form may result in processing delays for LTSS waiver applications.

Providers are encouraged to review the [SNF training presentation](#) for additional guidance on LTSS waiver requirements.
