

## New Payment Policy for Outpatient Physical and Occupational Rehabilitation Services September 18, 2020

Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island (Neighborhood) has revised its payment policy for Outpatient Physical and Occupational Rehabilitation Services for all lines of business (Medicaid, Commercial, and INTEGRITY), effective October 1, 2020.

Outpatient rehabilitation therapy services must relate directly and specifically to a written treatment plan (also known as the plan of care or plan of treatment) and the services must be performed by a contracted Physical or Occupational Therapist or a contracted Therapy group in order to be reimbursed. The new policy also includes procedures for Physical Therapy Assistants (PTAs) and Occupational Therapy Assistant (OTAs).

## Medicaid

Effective October 1, 2020, there is a benefit limit for Medicaid members requiring physical therapy (PT) and occupational therapy (OT).

- PT is covered without a prior authorization and is limited to 24 sessions per rolling year.
- OT is covered without a prior authorization and is limited to 24 sessions per rolling year.

## Commercial and INTEGRITY

The benefit coverage and payment policy remains unchanged at this time for Commercial and INTEGRITY members.

- PT is covered without prior authorization for the initial evaluation and 8 PT sessions per plan/calendar year. Any additional sessions require a prior authorization.
- OT is covered without prior authorization for the initial evaluation and 8 OT sessions per plan/calendar year. Any additional sessions require a prior authorization

## **Speech Therapy Services**

Similar to OT and PT services, effective October 1, 2020, there will now be a benefit limit for Medicaid members requiring speech therapy (ST).

• ST is covered without a prior authorization and is limited to 24 sessions per rolling year.

The benefit coverage and payment policy remains unchanged at this time for Commercial and INTEGRITY members.

• ST is covered without prior authorization for the initial evaluation and 8 ST sessions per plan/calendar year. Any additional sessions require a prior authorization.
