

Acupuncture Services Payment Policy for Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island Commercial Members

February 1, 2022

Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island (Neighborhood) has recently created an Acupuncture Services Payment Policy for Commercial Members. Although this is a new payment policy for Commercial members, this is not a new benefit.

• The <u>Acupuncture Services Payment Policy</u> outlines the scope, coverage, and billing guidelines for acupuncture services for Neighborhood Commercial members. Neighborhood Medicaid and INTEGRITY (MMP) billing guidance for acupuncture services in lieu of medications or invasive procedures for chronic pain, is outlined in Neighborhood's <u>In Lieu of Services Payment Policy</u>.

It is the provider's responsibility to verify eligibility, coverage, and authorization criteria prior to rendering services. All services must be medically necessary to qualify for reimbursement.
