

Cure's Act – Screening of Medicaid Providers

The 21st Century Cures Act (Cures Act), 114 P.L. 255, requires all Medicaid providers and pharmacies to be screened by and enrolled with the State Medicaid Agency by January 1, 2018. As a result of the Cures Act, and required under 42 CFR 438.602(b), the Rhode Island Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) must screen and enroll all managed care organization (MCO) providers and pharmacies.

On June 30, 2022; non-compliant pharmacies will be receiving notification from CVS Caremark as a reminder of the Cures Act screening and enrollment requirement.

Please be advised that continued non-compliance with the requirements may result in pharmacy claim denials at point of sale. Members experiencing rejected claims at point of sale should be advised to go to a different pharmacy that is enrolled with State Medicaid.

- Recipients have sixty (60) days from the date of notification to become compliant with the requirement.
- Providers must follow the guidance in the notification to enroll in RI Medicaid through the EOHHS web portal at <u>www.RIProviderPortal.org.</u>
