



Medicaid Stimulant Formulary Update

Neighborhood News – April 2023

In an effort to support patient access during the stimulant shortage, Neighborhood has removed Utilization Management criteria from or added stimulants to its Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit Formulary.

- As of March 1, 2023 generic Dexedrine ER was added to Neighborhood's Medicaid Formulary without Utilization Management criteria (without Prior Authorization or Step Therapy Requirements).
- As March 10, 2023, generic Concerta's Prior Authorization requirements will be removed (and there will be no Utilization Management criteria for this medication).

Additionally, as a reminder generic Adderall XR, generic Adderall, generic Dexedrine, generic Dexedrine ER, generic Strattera, generic Intuniv, generic Focalin, generic Focalin XR, generic Metadate CD, generic Ritalin LA, generic Ritalin, generic Methylin ER, and generic Concerta (as of 3/10/2023) are available without Prior Authorization/Step Therapy Utilization Management requirements on Neighborhood's Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit Formulary.
