



Cure's Act – Screening of Medicaid Providers

Neighborhood News – April 2023

The 21st Century Cures Act (Cures Act), 114 P.L. 255, requires all Medicaid providers and pharmacies to be screened by and enrolled with the State Medicaid Agency by January 1, 2018. As a result of the Cures Act, and required under 42 CFR 438.602(b), the Rhode Island Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) must screen and enroll all managed care organization (MCO) providers and pharmacies.

Please be advised that continued non-compliance with the requirements will result in pharmacy claim denials at point of sale, effective July 1, 2023.

Members experiencing rejected claims at point of sale should be advised to go to a different pharmacy that is enrolled with State Medicaid.

If you receive communication to enroll with RI Medicaid from multiple managed care plans, you only need to submit one application.
