

Pharmacy Webpage Restructuring May 15, 2023

Neighborhood's Pharmacy Department is excited to announce a restructuring of the Provider Resources Pharmacy webpage. The new design will make it easier to find important information and distinguish resources based on the line of business.

When visiting the new Provider Resources Pharmacy webpage, you will initially be directed to a page with three categories. (See **Figure 1**)

The first option, **Formularies and Preferred Drug Lists**, will bring you to a landing page that contains Formularies (PDF and Searchable) and additional formulary specific resources separated by line of business. (See **Figure 2**) You can return to the main Pharmacy webpage at any time by simply selecting "<u>Click here to get back to the main Pharmacy page</u>".
