Neighborhood News – July 2023

Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island’s (Neighborhood) Pharmacy Department has completed restructuring of its Provider Resources Pharmacy webpage. The new design makes it easier to find important information and distinguish resources based on the line of business.

When visiting the new Provider Resources Pharmacy webpage, you are now directed to a page with three categories. (Please see **Figure 1**)

The first option, **Formularies and Preferred Drug Lists**, brings you to a landing page that contains formularies (PDF and searchable) and additional formulary specific resources separated by line of business. (Please see **Figure 2**)

The second option, **Criteria and Clinical Medical Policies**, brings you to a landing page where you can find all of Neighborhood’s Medicaid and Commercial pharmacy benefit prior authorization criteria and Pharmacy medical benefit clinical medical policies, including oncology and hematology criteria. Additionally, there is a link to the Medical Pharmacy Benefit Searchable HCPCS Code Listing (J-code Listing) (Please see **Figure 3**).
