

## Update to Neighborhood's Telemedicine/Telephone Services Policy

## Neighborhood News - January 2024

Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island (Neighborhood) is informing providers of several important updates to the <u>current Telemedicine/Telephone Services Payment Policy</u>. The changes, **effective January 1, 2024**, will align our policy with updates from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the State of Rhode Island's Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS), following the conclusion of the Public Health Emergency (PHE).

The updates, noted below, can be found in the <u>new Telemedicine/Telephone Services Payment Policy</u> which is **effective January 1, 2024**.

## 1. Telemedicine Codes:

All codes within the telemedicine category have been reviewed. Codes that are included in CMS/EOHHS
guidance remain while all others have been removed. Please refer to the updated coding grid.

## 2. Cost Share for CPTs 99211 and 99212:

• With the conclusion of the PHE, cost sharing for CPT codes 99211 and 99212 will no longer be waived for Commercial plans. Members will now be responsible for the associated cost share for these services, in accordance with their individual plan provisions.
