As primary care physician (PCP) assignments are updated, please ensure that the member's assigned PCP is accurate. Providers should continue to verify member PCP information through <u>NaviNet</u>. If a member's PCP needs to be updated, providers may request a PCP change on behalf of a member by completing the <u>PCP Change eForm</u>.
